- 2 Alcohol will not be sold or supplied to any person for the consumption of another under the age of 18
- 3 Alcohol will not be consumed outside the premises
- 4 Alcohol will not be sold or supplied to any person who is or appears to be drunk
- 5 A tariff will be on show which details the price of any drink
- 6 Alcohol can only be served between the hours of 10.00am and 12.00pm
- 7 If bottles, cans or any other vessel which contained alcohol are found on the premises after an event a corkage charge could be made to the hirer of £5.00 per vessel

The following have the right to enter the premises and close the bar:

1 Any member of the Barbon Village Hall Committee

2 The Police

3 Trading Standards Officers

4 Environmental Health Officers

5 Fire Service, Building Control, and Council Licensing Officers

6 Customs and Excise Officers

Wedding and Parties where outside Bar Licensees are to be used

The Licensee who is running the Bar is required to obtain a "Tens Licence"

from the SLDC Licensing Office. They are then responsible for the sale and supply of alcohol.
